

**OFFEROR'S CERTIFICATION TO UNITED SPACE ALLIANCE, LLC (USA)
RELATIVE TO: e-VERIFY**

FAR clause 52.222-54, Employment Eligibility Verification (Jan 2009), will be included in any contract (as used here, "contract" means contract, subcontract or purchase order) resulting from this solicitation.

FAR clause 52.222-54 is amended as follows:

"Contractor" means Seller, except in "Federal Contractor" and "Policy for a Common Identification Standard for Federal Employees and Contractors," "Subcontract" means "Seller's subcontract." "Subcontractor" means "Seller's subcontractor," "Contract" means "this Order" except "contract" means "contract or this Order" in the definitions of "Employee assigned to the contract," "Subcontractor" and "Subcontract."

This clause requires your participation in the e-Verify program of the US Department of Homeland Security. The e-Verify program provides an Internet-based means of verifying employment eligibility of workers employed in the United States. If your company is not already enrolled as a Federal Contractor in e-Verify, this clause will require you to enroll within thirty days after award of a contract. Also, paragraph (e) of the clause will require you to include the requirements of the clause in certain lower tier subcontracts.
